

Hey team: I am happy to announce that we have just confirmed the skate park outreach for the weekend of Oct. 7-9. The event will take place on Saturday, October 8th, from 2-4 p.m. Please pray for the Ambassador Skateboards team, the event, and for us, as there are still a lot of logistical things to work out. Pray also for the fundraiser most likely at the end of August. It is still tentative, as there are a few unknown variables to firm up: 1) Can we use the Vet's Hall on September 24th (free of charge)? 2) Can we partner with The Center for Hope board to share the space and have an Art/Craft Fair? 3) Can we get volunteers (from our team & several others) to commit to working the event? 4) Can we get enough vendors/wares to sell items with or without The Center for Hope being involved?

After not having been able to hold any workshops or other events the first half of the year, it seems God is calling us to action in the second half of the year. As said before, we are not to be motivated by fear (of the enemy or the growing evil he is spewing on our community). We are to be motivated by faith, love, and concern for our community and all those who are lost and will be eternally separated from God, if someone doesn't reach out to them. We are concerned about the next generation who are growing up without moral and ethical moorings, which are only by-products of not having a spiritual foundation.

Schedule:

Your team to arrive Friday, October 7th.
Event will take place on Saturday, the 8th from 2-4 p.m. (with set up and drawing kids/youth in ahead of time)
Your team will share their testimonies or someone from your team will preach at Crossroads Christian Church on Sunday, the 9th. Our service starts at 10:30.

Details of event (per our discussion):

Your team will do a skateboard competition. They will also facilitate a "best trick" competition for 1-3 different age groups (depending on the demographics of who shows up). They will share a testimony/their testimonies at the end of event, and then give out awards for competition/s. They will provide a DJ.

Body Builders will provide: Free food and drink to attendees. Most likely we will provide children's activities at the neighboring tennis courts.

Accommodations:

Your team will be staying at the home of Pastor Gerry and Monica Burney (We live very close to the high school and skate park). We will provide homecooked meals (with the exception of a pizza dinner one night).

Fees/expenses:

Body Builders will pay an honorarium of \$2500.00 to Ambassador Skateboards team. We will also solicit local businesses to donate toward the prizes for the "best trick" competition.

Body Builders will also provide reimbursement for gas expense.

Expectation:

We trust that God will bring the increase as He shows favor on our stepping out in faith to partner with you to bring this event to fruition. We will be praying for your team and the event leading up to the event weekend.
