



# Recording Format and Outline Suggestion

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During a recording session it is important to have a loose script worked out. This can be an outline and simple lesson plan with details for the camera man to follow. During recording session there are basic rules for keeping the attention of the audience.

Learning how to implement the personal touches will give the session a fun and appealing look. The director will be responsible for communicating and documenting the show throughout all the different stages and the entire finished product.

## 3 Main parts to the finished product:

1. **Planning and communications** to the director. Before each session the outline or script will be discussed with the director. This includes details for set design and visual props. During this time the script or outline will include the flow of video and audio effects.
  2. **Recording session** time is very important with much detail to lighting, cropping, and sound. There is always a learning curve and sometimes it will mean doing it over a few times to get the desired result.
  3. **Post editing and delivery** is one of the items that can make all the pieces come together. In the outline or script we will learn how to influence the editing for the highest quality product.
